- One-hour plus training every four years
 - Training within 6 months of hire
 - All personnel within district, anyone who receives direct or indirect payment from the school

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- Age-appropriate child sexual abuse prevention education for students delivered by qualified instructors**
- Grades pre-K through 5

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- School District child sexual abuse response and reporting procedures**
- Follow mandated reporting requirements and system
 - Do not interview a child or ask clarifying questions
 - Know your schools referral system
